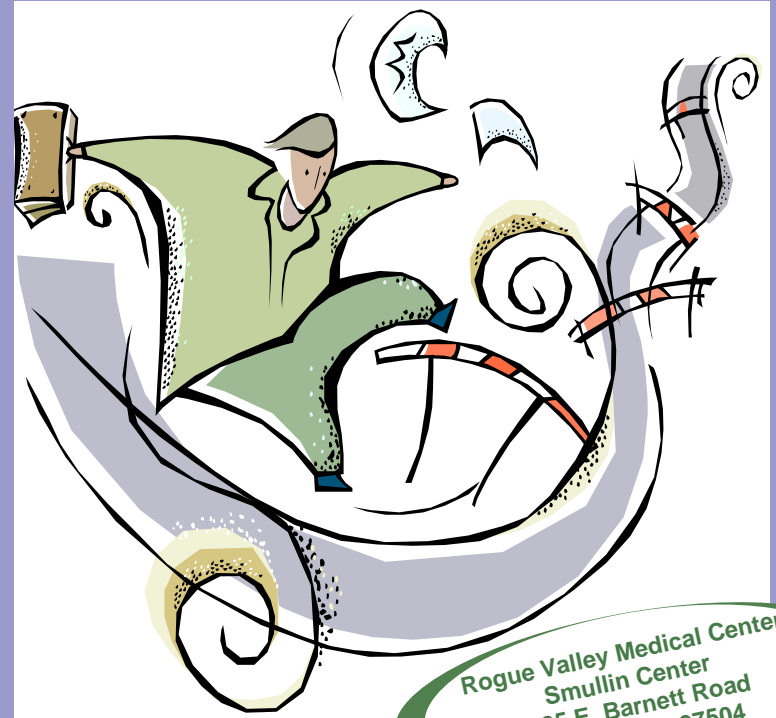

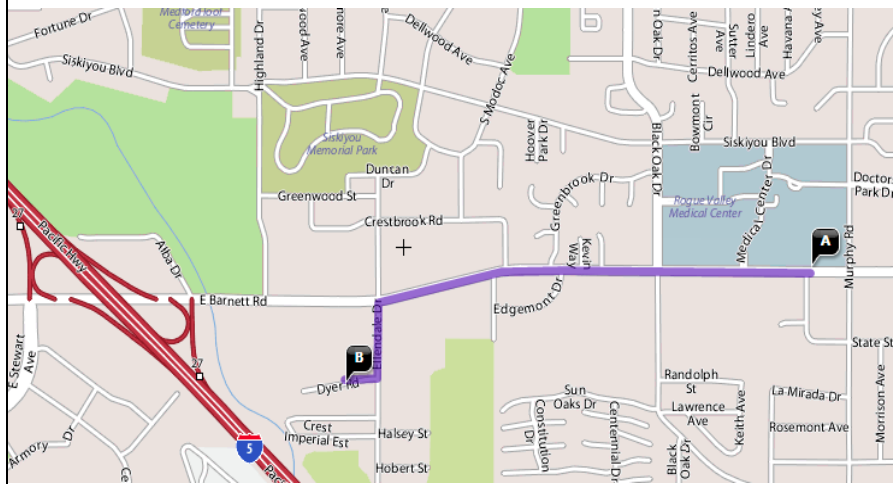
Directions to Homewood Suites

OCRA Objectives
