
Directions to RiverBend Hospital

From I-5 heading North: Take I-5 North to Exit 195A-195B. Stay to the right when exiting and do not go left over flyover bridge. Get into left hand lane and turn right onto Randy Pape Beltline. Continue straight as road curves and your destination will be on your left. Big red brick building, can't miss it!

From I-5 heading South: Take I-5 South to Exit 195, Randy Pape Beltline. Stay in left hand lane as you exit and turn Left at Light. Continue straight as road curves and your destination will be on your left. Big red brick building, can't miss it!

From Bend: Take Hwy 20 To Hwy 126/McKenzie Hwy. Continue on this highway to Springfield (you will take a right turn towards Springfield onto Hwy 126 after 76 Station). Take exit toward Springfield City Center. Turn left onto Q Street; Turn right onto Pioneer Pkwy. At the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit onto Martin Luther King Jr Pkwy. Parking Instructions



Where to go once you have parked
